WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

Mysterious blend or special winemaking? We took the fruity Catawba, once considered the Queen of Missouri grapes, and applied some special winemaking techniques. Very cold fermentation stopped at a slightly lower alcohol to capture the maximum aroma potential and early bottling to retain fermentation fizz for a lively palate.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION:

Alcohol - 8.0% Residual Sugar - 6.0%

TASTING INFORMATION:

A sweet rosé wine bursting with aromas of honeysuckle and lychee. This light and delicate wine is refreshing with subtle spritz and flavors of red grapefruit and wild strawberries. (750 ml)
